

Chief Rocker Busy Bee aka David Parker is one of the Greatest MC's of all time. he's a songwriter, producer, artist, arranger, promoter and innovator. His Hip Hop career was inspired by Melle Mell and Kid Creole (Furious Five) Busy comes from a long line of party style MC's from Coke La Rock, Eddie Cheba, Hollywood, Kurtis Blow and LoveBug Starski. For over 40 years Busy Bee has been entertaining crowds of Hip Hop followers. He is one of the few Solo artist in the late 1970's who could rock a crowd. When a party promoter needed someone to turn up at a party, they called Busy Bee. His storytelling rhymes and crowd participation made him a house hold name in Hip Hop. The Chief Rocker was rhyming and singing in the early 1980's long before some of the artist that are heard today.

One of Busy Bee's famous lyrics;
"and when it's time to work it out we take them straight down to the house and shoot some sp.... that jingle jangle jingle"
Another routine Busy made famous was;
"I go bob with the bob da dang a dang diggy diggy, shake ya boogie to the bang bang"

Busy Bee recorded several singles that were great songs and made the top 40 BillBoard Charts. He was signed to a few labels starting with SugarHill records before recording with Strong City/Uni/MCA and Blazin'. Busy Bee released two albums "Thank God for Busy Bee" in 1992 on Pandisc records and His Gold album "Running Thangs" in 1988. One of his greatest hits was titled "Suicide" which featured his unique ability to flow like water on a track.

One of his famous recorded lyrics was;
"When I was a young boy, I played in South Bronx, I never carried a gun I'm knocking out chumps"

Busy Bee has over a hundred trophies and awards from battles and contest that he's won over the years. He is sometimes referred to as the Chief Rocker, Non Stopper, Crowd Pleaser and the Don of the first generation of Solo MC's. His accomplishments has not been surpassed by any other MC. Busy Bee was a modern day Kanye West. (Genius) The Chief Rocker taught many young MC's and Rappers how to perform on stage and capture an audience. For many years other MC's tried to imitate his style, but there is only One Chief Rocker Busy bee.

Busy Bee stays busy with his energy and charismatic personality, he continues to perform and record

after 40 years in the business. Longevity is key to his continued success in Hip Hop. In 1981, he won the New Music Seminar MC World Supremacy Belt.

In 1983, he was featured in the first Hip Hop film "WildStyle".

In 2002, he had a cameo in "Paid in Full" and included in the Documentary "Hip Hop Legends"

Busy bee has collaborated with hundreds of artist. Most recently with KRS one and Marley Marl on the 2007 album "Hip Hop Lives"

The Legendary Chief Rocker Busy Bee is one of the Greatest Solo Artist of all time.
